GENERAL RULES AND INSTRUCTIONS:

Complete the application and print it out, sign and date it, and return it to the GHS Guidance Counselor. You are allowed to print the blank application and complete it by hand if necessary. The completed application and any attachments are **due on the date specified by the GHS Guidance Counselor for all local scholarship applications**. Late applications will not be accepted.

Grade Point Average Requirement: There is no minimum cumulative GPA requirement.

Who is Eligible: Graduating Genesee High School students who have taken Agriculture classes and have actively participated in FFA activities for two or more years. *Applicants must be current FFA members in good standing.*

Release of Funds: Funds may be released directly to the student or may be released directly to your chosen institution of higher education, at the discretion of the Genesee FFA Alumni organization. Students must be enrolled full time in a 2 or 4 year college or technical school. Half of the funds will be available for each of the first two terms following graduation. Exceptions to this rule will be made on a case by case basis.

Rules and Selection: Rules and selection criteria for the Genesee FFA Alumni Scholarship will be approved by the general assembly of the Genesee FFA Alumni Association. Parents, guardians and family members of applicants are not permitted to serve on the scholarship selection committee. All rules are subject to change without notice.

Awards: Scholarships awarded vary year to year. The scholarship committee will decide on the number and amount of awards based on funds available. There is an automatic award of \$250 if the applicant has earned his or her FFA State Degree.

Attachments: Include the following items in your application packet. Late or incomplete applications will not be accepted. You may add additional pages if there is not enough room for your information.
