TITLE: After-School STEM Program Paraprofessional (Grades 7-12)

SUMMARY: To support the Lead Advisor in coordinating and supervising an after-school STEM Program funded by the “Out of School STEM Programming Grant”.

3. Help prepare and manage STEM materials, supplies, and equipment, ensuring their availability and organization.
4. Foster student engagement and enthusiasm for STEM subjects, encouraging questions, exploration, and hands-on learning.
5. Collaborate with parents, the lead advisor, and school staff to ensure seamless coordination with the afterschool program.
6. Ability to ensure that work is completed according to set schedules.
