- Are the widow or widower of such individuals and who have not remarried, OR
- Are the qualifying spouses of eligible disabled veterans who cannot qualify for any public employment because of a service-connected disability?

Examples of some of the most common campaign medals are: Vietnam (Service Medal), El Salvador, Lebanon, Granada, Panama, Bosnia, Kosovo, Afghanistan, Southwest Asia (Persian Gulf), Somalia, and Haiti. (Award of the National Defense Service medal alone does NOT qualify.)
