

Supplemental Levy Election 2021 (FY22)

The Genesee Joint School District #282 will be asking voters on March 9, 2021 to vote on the proposed one-year levy of \$985,000. This supplemental levy allows the district to maintain the quality educational programs and opportunities for students of the Genesee Joint School District #282.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of **\$447.70 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value**, per year, based on current conditions. This is **down** \$20.52 per \$100,000 from the previous year. Currently, the District collects a supplemental levy authorized in the amount of \$935,000 which will expire when the proposed levy (\$985,000) goes into effect on July 1, 2020.

The determination of the levy amount is based on the discrepancy between the revenue the district receives from state and federal funding and the educational needs as determined by the Board of Trustees. Taking into account the property tax reduction provided by the agricultural equipment replacement exemption and the personal business property tax exemption, the **estimated cost of the levy will be approximately \$932,881**

The supplemental levy allows the district to support educational and extra-curricular programs for students attending the Genesee Joint School district for the 2021/22 school year.
