Dear Parents, Guardians and Stakeholders,

As we prepare for school to reopen this fall, we have spent the past three months reviewing different protocols around the region, state, as well as the country. We have developed our protocols with input from the State Board of Education (SBOE), our Local Department of Health (DOH), as well as seeking input of staff, parents and students.

This guidance is grounded in my belief that we need to provide the best educational opportunity for our students which is provided through face to face instruction. We do realize that there may still be concern for students or parents/families who may have health risks or other issues that may prevent them from returning to a face to face learning environment. We will be looking at providing options for those students who will be choosing to continue “at home” learning during the 2020/21 school year.
