Supplemental Levy Election – March 14, 2023 (FY24)

The Genesee Joint School District #282 will be asking voters on March 14, 2023 to RENEW the district's one-year levy of \$1,185,000. This supplemental levy allows our district to maintain the quality of educational programs and opportunities for students of the Genesee Joint School District #282.

The estimated average annual cost to the taxpayer on the proposed levy is a tax of \$ 442.46 per \$100,000 of taxable assessed value (\$4.42 per 1,000), per year, based on current conditions. Currently, the District collects a supplemental levy authorized in the amount of \$1,185,000 which will expire when the proposed levy (\$1,185,000) goes into effect on July 1, 2023.

The determination of the levy amount is based on the discrepancy between the revenue the district receives from state and federal funding and the educational needs as determined by the Board of Trustees. Considering the property tax reduction provided by the agricultural equipment replacement exemption and the personal business property tax exemption, **the estimated cost of the levy will be approximately \$1,113,881.00.**

JUNIORS: Idaho School Day SAT on Wednesday, April 12th

The Idaho State Department of Education (S.D.E.) has a contracted with The College Board, the company who designs and administers the SAT test. **Under this contract the S.D.E. will pay for all Idaho public school juniors to take the SAT on the morning of Wednesday, April 12th.**

If preferred students can also take the ACT test, but the student will be responsible for the testing fee and you must plan to get yourself registered for the test and plan to take it on one of the Saturday national test dates. More info on available testing dates and test fees at www.act.org.

The SAT on April 12th will take all morning, starting at 8:00am and running through the lunch hour. The school will provide snacks during the test as well as lunch after the test before releasing students to their afternoon classes.

Free SAT Practice resources at Khan Academy

JUNIORS: There is still time to improve your SAT scores by spending time practicing on the free Khan Academy SAT program. If you haven't already done so, log into your account at www.collegeboard.org, then link your PSAT results to the Khan Academy practice site for a personalized SAT practice program that includes thousands of SAT questions and four full-length SAT practice tests. Even an hour or two a week between now and the test can help you feel more familiar with the SAT format and more comfortable to do your best work on April 9th.
