#### JUNIORS: Idaho School Day SAT on Wednesday, April 12th

The Idaho State Department of Education (S.D.E.) has a contracted with The College Board, the company who designs and administers the SAT test, for several years now. **Under this contract the S.D.E. will pay for all Idaho public school juniors to take the SAT on the morning of Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup>.** 

The SAT on April 12<sup>th</sup> will take all morning, starting at 8:00am and running through the lunch hour. The school will provide snacks during the test as well as pizza for lunch right after the test, before releasing students to their afternoon classes.

I will also meet with the juniors during second period on Tuesday, April 11<sup>th</sup>, to help them fill in their demographic information on their answer sheets in advance of the test. This will shorten the length of our test session by about 45 minutes, so please try to be in attendance for Careers class on Tuesday as well.

Students may be opted out of taking the SAT test by their parent. Please contact Mr. Scripter by April 5<sup>th</sup> if you wish to opt your student out of the SAT. However, I would encourage juniors planning to attend college to take the SAT, as the results are used to help place college freshmen in the most appropriate Math and English courses.

Please do everything in your power to ensure your son or daughter in the junior class will be in attendance all day on Wednesday, April 12<sup>th</sup>. #### Free SAT Practice resources at Khan Academy

**JUNIORS**: There is still time to improve your SAT scores by spending time practicing on the free Khan Academy SAT program. If you haven't already done so, log into your account at <a href="www.collegeboard.org">www.collegeboard.org</a>, then link your PSAT results to the Khan Academy practice site for a personalized SAT practice program that includes thousands of SAT questions and four full-length SAT practice tests. Even an hour or two a week between now and the test can help you feel more familiar with the SAT format and more comfortable to do your best work on April 12<sup>th</sup>. # Four Year Plan Workshop: 8<sup>th</sup> Graders & Parents Tuesday May 16<sup>th</sup> @ 7:00pm

The State Department of Education's Idaho Administrative Code for Public Schools requires that all students have a Four Year Plan developed and placed in their school file by the end of the eighth grade year. This plan is to be the cooperative effort of the student and their parents, with the assistance of school personnel. The primary objective of this plan is to develop an initial plan of academic course choices for the four years of high school. Another desired outcome of this plan is to help the students to perceive the connection between their high school course choices and the impact those will have on their educational and/or career options after high school.

Mr. Scripter will be conducting a Four Year Plan Workshop for eighth graders and their parents here at the school on Tuesday, May 16<sup>th</sup>. The workshop will run from 7:00-8:00p.m. and will be held in the multi-purpose room. Again, <u>all students</u> are required to have a four year academic plan for high school by the end of the eighth grade year, so please make every effort to attend this event.

#### **Local Scholarships for Graduating Seniors**

As we did beginning with the class of 2020, all local scholarship applications and supporting documents will be submitted digitally. Seniors have been provided digital folders and their own copies of all the scholarship application forms, which only they and Mr. Scripter have access to. After the submission deadline Mr. Scripter will distribute all of the applications and documents to the groups responsible for evaluating the applications and selecting the recipients.

The deadline for seniors to submit all applications and supporting documents for this year's local scholarships is by 4:00pm on Thursday, April 27<sup>th</sup>.

Children ages 0-3 — April 14 (Friday), 2023 8:30 am to 2:00 pm at Genesee School in the multipurpose room. 330 W. Ash, Genesee, ID. Please bring your child's immunization record. The screening process will take 45-60 minutes.

Children ages 3-5 - April 14 (Friday), 2022 8:30 am to 2:00 pm at Genesee School in the multipurpose room. 330 W. Ash, Genesee, ID. Kindergarten registration for children not enrolled in preschool who will attend kindergarten in the fall will take place at the same time.

Please bring your child's birth certificate and immunization records. Please allow 1-1 1/2 hours for the screening process. (testing is optional)

Kindergarten ready (must be 5 by September 1st) will be from 8:30-2:00pm. Preschool ready (must be 4 by September 1st) will be from 8:30-2:00pm.
