To the students, parents, staff and patrons of Genesee School:

I just want to take this opportunity to say how appreciative I am to have spent the past twenty-one years working in this school and community. For most of my life I had heard the expression, "Raising kids takes a village." But it wasn't until I became part of the school team here that I really got to feel and experience how true this expression can be.

As I sat through my final Genesee graduation as a staff member the other day, I realized what a unique and special experience it has been to work with students as they pass through junior high and high school. Here we are afforded the opportunity of helping to teach, guide, mentor and support students for six years; and even longer for all our staff who work with students PreK-12. This is the only school I ever worked at, but I have to believe that people who work in schools where they have a completely new group of students every year can't possibly experience the same depth and breadth of relationships with students and their families, as we are so privileged to experience here. At least in my position, the depth of those relationships has made it hurt more when a student is working through hard things, more joyful seeing students grow and celebrate successes, and more fulfilling when so many students stay in touch after they leave our school. And throughout all the ups (and less frequent downs), I have always felt the strength of our great team here in the building and that of the community that is so supportive of our mission.

I hope that Genesee and this school will continue to feel like an exceptionally safe place for youth. Where it is annoyingly hard for kids to get away with much; but where that also lets them know they are cared for. A place where we all strive to help <u>all students</u> feel connected and supported, in a way that isn't as subject to the unnecessary and hurtful divisiveness of the political climate in our country as a whole. A place where students still routinely learn and display the respect, courtesy and manners of an older time, and also carry the values of being open-minded, accepting and kind. From the perspective of my role as the counselor here, I can assure you that your/our youth desperately need to feel accepted and protected from the ugly judgement and divisiveness which is so widely evident on their devices and in the world around them; <u>now more than ever.</u>

If I can offer one related nugget of experience above all others I have learned from my efforts to teach students and especially from listening to young people share their experiences in my office for twenty-one years, it would be this:

No matter how often we tell and overtly teach kids how we *want them* to behave, treat others, etc., <u>what we model ourselves</u>-- kind or unkind-- will always have more influence on their actions.

THANK YOU to everyone who has been a part of my time here at Genesee School. I never could have imagined how much a job--and the people I would get know in the process--could enrich my life; in ways I can't put sufficient words to. This school will always feel like home to me, and I hope to keep my connections to this place and the people here for a long time to come.
