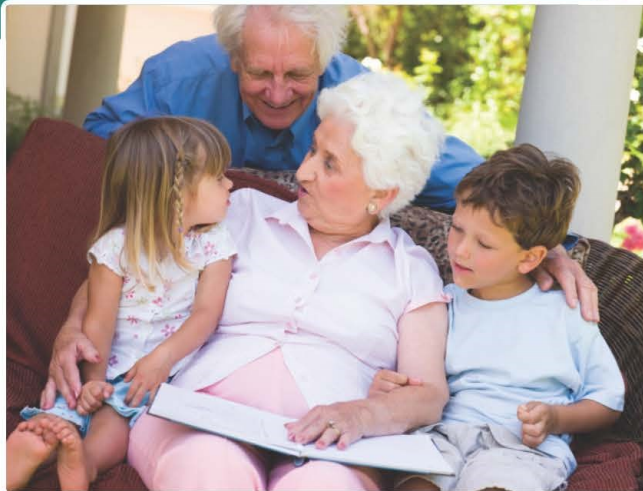

Genesee Child Find

The Genesee Joint School District, in cooperation with parents and nonpublic school agencies, engages in Child Find services throughout the school year. Child Find activities are conducted (1) to create public awareness of special education programs, (2) to advise the public that students who qualify for services have the right to a free appropriate public education and confidentiality protections, and (3) to alert community residents that a process exists for identifying and serving children with disabilities from the age of 3 through the semester in which they turn 21.

If you know of a child who is 3 through 21 years of age who may have individual needs that result from disabilities or developmental delays, and who is not enrolled in a school program, please contact the Genesee Joint School District office at 208-285-1161. These children may have difficulty walking, talking, hearing, or learning, or may display behaviors that appear different from other children their age.

Genesee Joint School District will be holding a Child Find screening on Friday April 12th with appointments starting at 8:30. Please contact the high school office at 208-285-1162 to schedule a screening time for this event.

Pups Baseball Camp

Come develop your baseball skills at the Genesee ball parks on April 12th! The camp will focus on the 3 fundamental keys to baseball: Batting, fielding, and base running. Campers will receive instruction from the Genesee High School Baseball team, headed by Teak Wareham who was a member of the 2021 state champion and 2022 state runner-up teams. Cost for the camp is \$25 per player and all proceeds will go towards the baseball program. Your players will not only grow their baseball skills at this camp, but also their leadership, work ethic, and teamwork skills. Both boys and girls are welcome!

Kids in 3rd, 4th, and 5th grade will start at 9:30 a.m. and finish at 11:30 a.m. Older kids, in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade, will go from 12 p.m. to 3 p.m. Hotdogs, chips, and water will be provided for all kids in between the two sessions. The older kids will also have a skills exhibition/scrimmage in the evening on April 13th, where parents are invited to see what the kids have learned. Camp participants will receive a camp T-shirt, and a CAT hat courtesy of Western States CAT.
